ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATE

DENR-NCR hereby grants Environmental Compliance Certificate (ECC) for the **GASOLINE SERVICE STATION** of **CALTEX PHILIPPINES, INC.** located in 4,943 square meters parcel of land located at Km. 17, Bgy. Canumay, North Luzon Expressway Valenzuela Metro Manila, after complying with the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) System requirements as prescribed in the guidelines of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Presidential Decree No. 1586

This Certificate is issued subject to the following conditions:

I. CONSTRUCTION STAGES:

1. That the proponent shall conduct orientation for resident engineers and contractor who will undertake and implement the project, to apprise them of the conditions/stipulations of this ECC and the necessary measures that will mitigate adverse environmental impacts, and submit report within 15 days from date of orientation;
2. That a billboard measuring 0.9 meter by 1.0 meter, bearing "NCR-2000-07-31-0144-120 issued pursuant to P.D. 1586" shall be displayed in a conspicuous location at the project site for identification and guidance;

II. OPERATION STAGE:

3. That this certificate covers the filling/refilling, car washing/lubrication/other related car repair and maintenance services, retail sale shop and storage of petroleum products consisting of 4-6,000 gallons capacity for Premium, 4-6,000 gallons capacity for Diesel, 2-6,000 gallons capacity for Unleaded; any modification from the approved project scope shall be officially relayed to this Office for its information, evaluation and approval;


III. OTHERS.

4. That all the proposed mitigation measures contained in the Environmental Management Plan shall be effected;
5. That reworks/grading of the exposed grounds and planting of trees/shrubs/ornamental plants shall be immediately undertaken for enhancement and ecological purposes;
6. That no chemical or hazardous waste shall be discharged to the canal or sewer;
7. That should adverse impacts occur as a result of project operations, all the activities causing the same shall be temporarily stopped until such time that remedial measures have been effected and inform this Office within the day through any means of communications;

8. That in case of abandonment, the project proponent shall inform this Office thirty (30) days before abandonment and to restore the site to its original condition or provide safety protective measures for protection purposes and to prevent adverse environmental impacts.
9. That the transfer of ownership and/or change of name of the project carries the same conditions in this ECC for which written agreement shall be made, copy furnish this Office of the said document for records purposes;
10. That the project proponent shall allow DENR NCR personnel with proper identification card and travel order to conduct inspection/monitoring in the entire premises without prior notice to oversee compliance to ECC conditions;
11. That this Certificate shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the Administration's Office for easy reference and guidance;
12. That a report on the results of monitoring proposed under the Environmental Monitoring Plan of the Initial Environmental Examinations and on compliance with each of the conditions shall be submitted to this Office semi-annually under oath;
13. That the Project Proponent shall allow only collectors with permit from DENR to collect and transport used oil; and
14. That a written notification shall be made to the DENR-NCR for approval in case the project proponent cannot comply with any of the conditions for technical reasons.

Non-compliance with any of the above stipulations and/or misrepresentations in the IEE submitted by the proponent will be sufficient cause for the suspension or cancellation of this Certificate and/or imposition of a fine in an amount not to exceed Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00) for every violation thereof pursuant to Article IX, Section 6.0, DENR Administrative Order No. 37, Series of 1986. This ECC is not a permit rather it is a certification that the proponent has committed to undertake or implement mitigative measures to reduce the negative impacts to acceptable level.

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
